We have a Post Doctoral Researcher/Senior Research Assistant position available in global change marine biology for 12 months starting in August 2020

The precise subject of the project will be decided by agreement between the candidate and supervisor, with the decision guided by our mutual interests and strengths.

The focus could include:

- Global changes such as ocean acidification, warming, freshening
- The combined impact of global and local environmental change
 - Physiology and direct effects
 - Biotic interactions and indirect effects

Applicants should possess either a PhD or a Master's degree. They should have experience in research focussing on marine ecology, climate change biology (especially ocean warming or acidification), or another marine biology related discipline. The ideal candidate possesses a toolkit comprised of a solid foundation of laboratory experiments, capacity to measure physiological and behavioural organism responses, an understanding of seawater chemistry, as well as a proven ability to undertake the associated fieldwork (i.e. sampling of water conditions, collection of experimental organisms).

A competitive salary (including benefits) commensurate with qualifications and experience will be offered.
