Post Doctoral Researcher/Senior Research Assistant

We have a Post Doctoral Researcher/Senior Research Assistant position available in global change marine biology for 12 months. The successful candidate is expected to begin with us by February 2023, preferably sooner.

The project will focus on the ecology of marine invertebrates, with a particular emphasis on:

- a) Experiments considering the effects of global changes such as ocean acidification, warming, and freshening on physiology and behaviour
- b) Field surveys and experiments considering the role of invasive bivalves on Hong Kong's shorelines

Applicants should possess either a PhD or Master's degree. They should have experience in research focussing on marine ecology, climate change biology (especially ocean warming or acidification), invasive species impacts, or another marine biology related discipline. The ideal candidate possesses a toolkit comprised of an ability to undertake fieldwork (e.g., biodiversity surveys, monitoring of water conditions, collection of experimental organisms), experience running laboratory experiments, and a track record of producing research outputs.

A competitive salary (including benefits) commensurate with qualifications and experience will be offered.
